Meeting organisation:

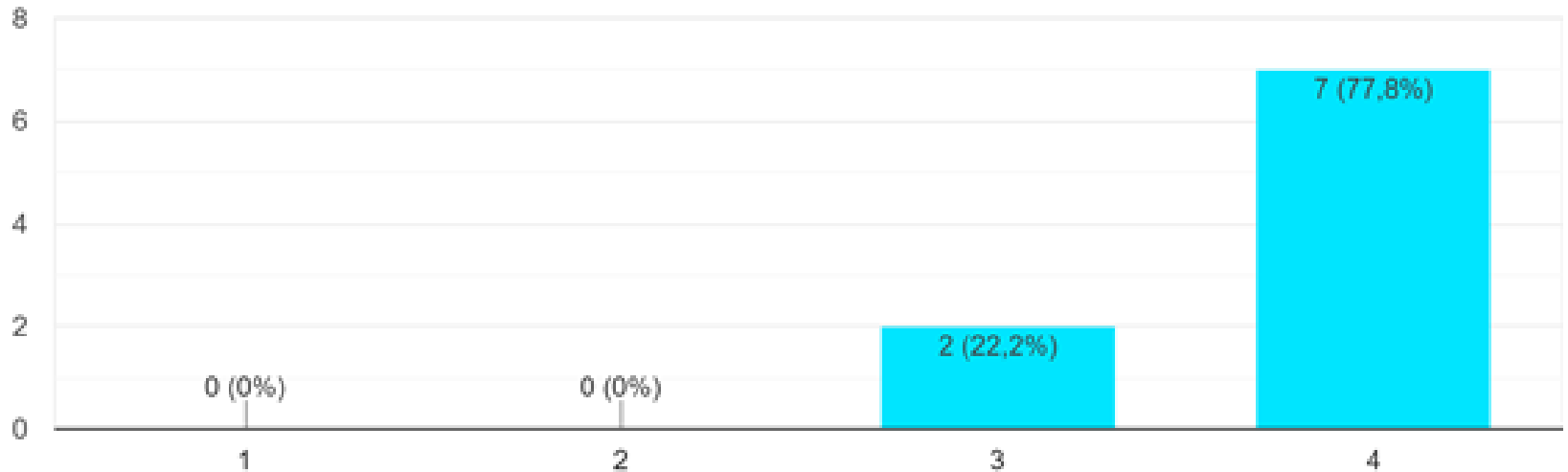

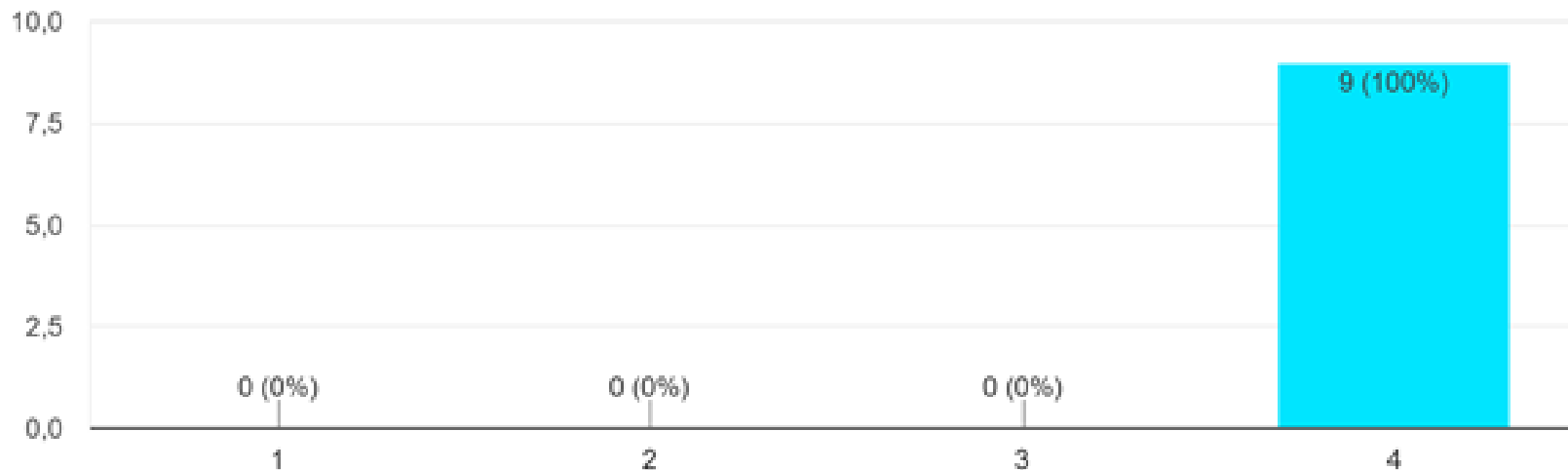

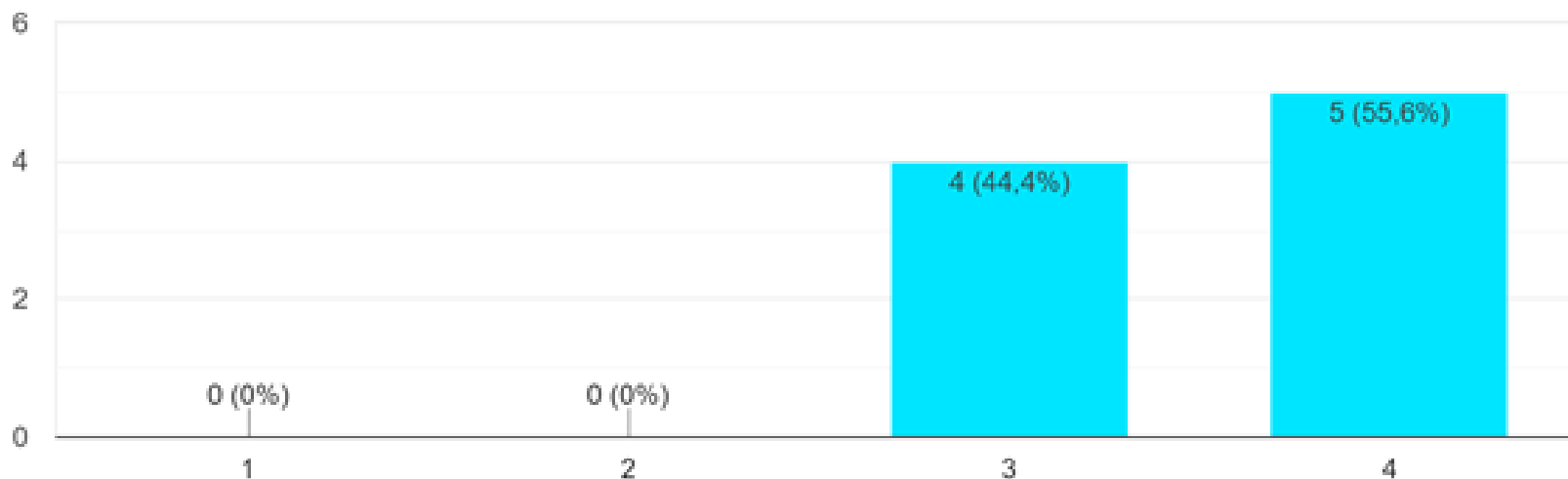

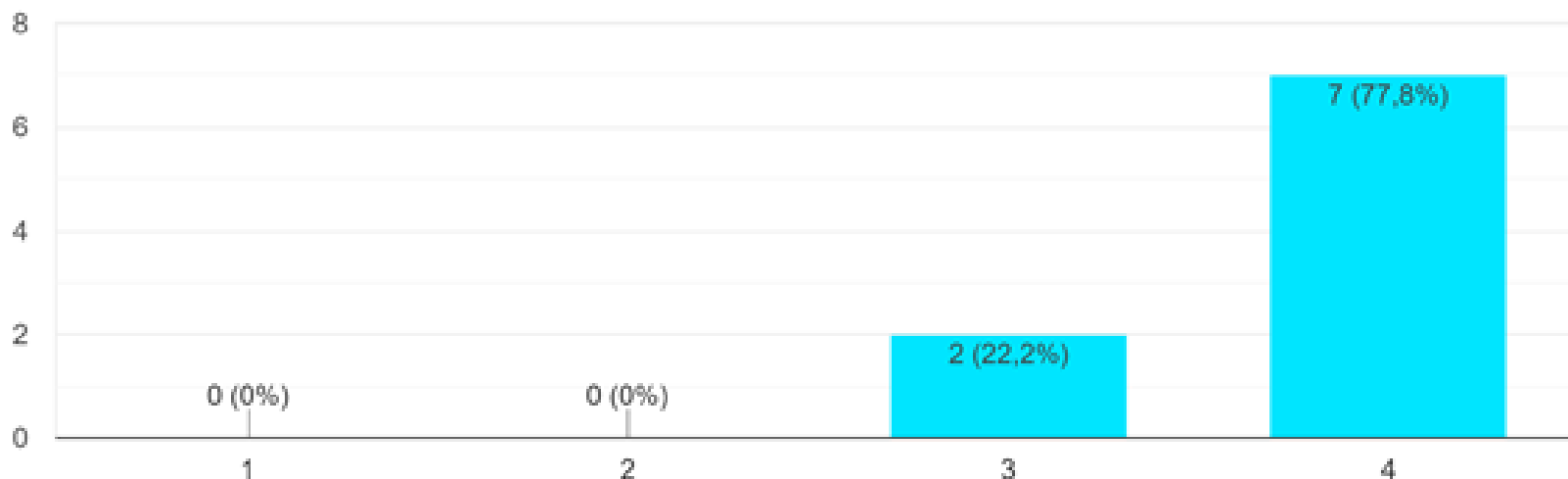

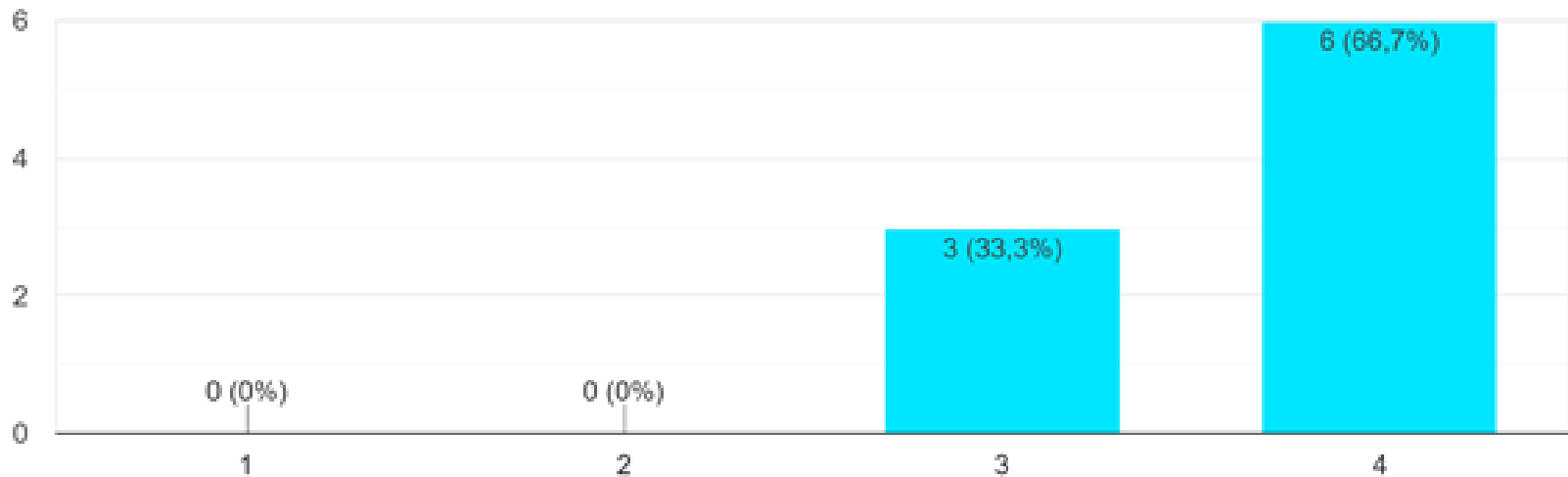

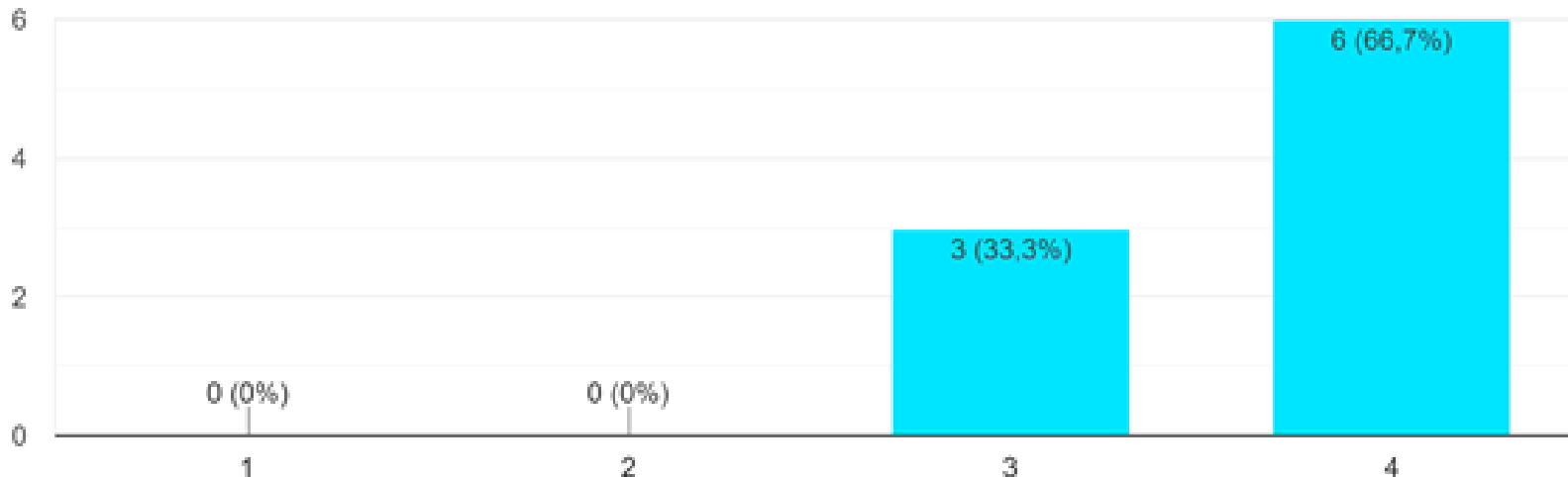
